Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) Policy of WBIDFC

1.0 CSR Vision Statement and Objective:

West Bengal Infrastructure Development Finance Corporation Limited (WBIDFC), through its Corporate Social Responsibility initiatives, shall continue to undertake projects for sustainable development, mainly focusing on fulfilment of food, shelter, health & education needs of the society.

The aim of the Corporate Social Responsibility Policy (CSR Policy) is to ensure that the Corporation becomes a socially responsible corporate entity committed to improving the quality of life of the society at large.

1.1 The objective of the WBIDFC CSR policy is to:

1. Take up projects that provide food, shelter, health & education facilities to the marginalized and underprivileged sections.
2. Contribute to inclusive growth and equitable development in society through education, capacity building measures, empowerment of the marginalized and underprivileged sections/communities.
3. Generate a societal goodwill for WBIDFC through CSR activities and help reinforce a positive & socially responsible image of WBIDFC as a corporate.

2.0 Strategy:

- 2.1 As a responsible corporate entity, WBIDFC shall consistently strive to meet the expectations of the society by supporting initiatives for improving life of the marginalized and underprivileged sections irrespective of caste, creed or community. It shall not support activities which may create dissatisfaction within the society and which may affect social harmony in any manner.
- 2.2 CSR strategies should be developed with a shift from *ad-hoc* approach to the project-based accountability approach.
- 2.3 While implementing the CSR projects, WBIDFC shall strive to undertake:
 1. At least one project for the development of a backward district in the State of West Bengal and
